Overnight Parking-Municipal Parking Lot

1. Prohibition. No motor vehicle, trailer, camper, boat, or other conveyance may be parked in the municipal parking lot located at 129 W. Old Main Rd. between 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. on any day unless a valid Town-issued overnight parking permit is displayed. The purpose of this policy is to keep the lot available for municipal use, allow for snow removal and maintenance, and prevent unauthorized long-term storage of vehicles.

2. Permits. Overnight parking permits may be obtained at the Town Office during regular hours. Each permit is issued to a specific vehicle by registration number, is non-transferable, and must be displayed on the driver's-side dashboard or so that it is visible from outside the vehicle. Permits may be issued for a set term or on a temporary basis, and the Board or its designee may revoke any permit for misuse, misrepresentation, or violation of this policy.

3. Enforcement. Any vehicle parked in violation of this policy is subject to removal and storage by a towing service authorized by the Town, at the sole risk and expense of the vehicle's owner. All towing, storage, and administrative charges are the responsibility of the owner and must be paid before the vehicle is released. The Town of Lowell assumes no liability for damage to or loss from any vehicle towed or stored under this policy. Signs stating the overnight restriction and towing consequences shall be posted at the lot entrance. The Board of Selectmen, or its designee, may grant temporary exceptions for mechanical breakdown, weather emergencies, or Town-sponsored events.
