


To: Lori Moura, a resident of the Town of Lowell, in the County of Penobscot, State of Maine.

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Lowell in said county and state, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to appear at the Town Office in said Town on Tuesday, the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June, A.D. 2024, at eight o'clock in the forenoon, then and there to act upon Article 1 and by secret ballot on Article 2 as set out below, the polling hours therefor to be from eight o'clock in the forenoon until eight o'clock in the afternoon, said articles being the following:

Referendum Article 1: To elect a moderator to preside at said meeting.


Referendum Article 2: Shall the Town vote to authorize the Select Board to complete the establishment of and entry into the Central Maine Highlands Fire and EMS District #1 (the "District"), a regional fire district under Title 30-A, Chapter 164 of the Maine Revised Statutes with the towns of Howland, Passadumkeag, Maxfield, Burlington, Enfield and Edinburg, as well as Seboeis Plantation and Penobscot County and such other municipalities and municipal entities as the named municipalities may deem appropriate, and to enter into a lease of a portion of the Fire House and existing fire equipment of the Town of Howland to the District and to allocate future debt of the District proportionately between its members?
